

NUMBERS

במדבר (Bemidbar), 1st weekly portion and Hebrew name of the fourth book, Numbers, of the Pentateuch

Chapter 1:

vs 16: קרויאני is read as קרויאני (keru'e)

Chapter 2:

vs 9: כּל-הפקודים (kol-hapekudeém) is recited in *high na'um*

** מאַת אֵלִיף (me'at élif) is recited as מאַת אֵלִיף

vs 16: כּל-הפקודים (kol hapekudeém) is recited in *high na'um*

** מאַת אֵלִיף (me'at élif) is recited as מאַת אֵלִיף

vs 24: כּל-הפקודים (kol-hapekudeém) is recited in *high na'um*

Chapter 3:

vs 25: מְכַסְּחוּ (meechséhu) is recited as מְכַסְּחוּ *

vs 38: אֶחָל-מוֹעֵד מְזַרְחָה (óhil-mongid meezrá'hah) is recited as אֶחָל-מוֹעֵד מְזַרְחָה. A פָּסֵק (1) (*pasik*) is inserted between מוֹעֵד (mongid) and מְזַרְחָה (meezrá'hah)

vs 51: חַפְּדוּיִם is read as חַפְּדוּיִם (happeduycém)

Chapter 4:

vs 14: אֶת-כָּל-כְּלָיו (it-kol-kélaf) is recited in *high na'um*

נָסוֹ (Nasó), 2nd weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 5:

vs 9: וְכָל-תְּרוּמָהּ (vechól-terumah) is recited in *high na'um*

vs 10: after this verse no רְבִיעִי (rebeengee) but after Chapter 6, vs 27.

Chaph 6 - vs 28

Chapter 7:

vs 1: וַיִּמְשַׁח אֹתוֹ (vayeemsha'h oto) is recited as וַיִּמְשַׁח אֹתוֹ (vayeemsha'h oto) in *high na'um* ****

vs 5: וְהָיוּ (vehayu) is recited as וְהָיוּ *

- vs 22

After vs 11: חַמִּישֵׁי (*hameeshée*)

vs 85: חַמִּישֵׁי

בְּהַאֲלֹתֶכָּהּ (Behágalotechá), 3rd weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 8:

vs 22: וְאַחֲרֵי-כֵן (ve'achare-chin) is recited in *high na'um*

Chapter 10:

vs 36: וּבְנֹחוֹ (ubnucho) is read as וּבְנֹחוֹ

Chapter 11:

verses 1 to 7 are recited in low voice

vs 4: וְהִסְפִּסְוּ is read as וְהִסְפִּסוּ (ve'hásafsuf)

vs 32: אֶת-הַשֵּׁלֶוֹ is read as אֶת-הַשְּׁלִי (it-hasseláv)

vs 33: is recited in low voice

Chapter 12:

vs 3: עָנָו is read as עָנִי (nganáv)

שֵׁלַח-לֶךְ (Shela'h-Lecha), 4th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 14:

vs 19: סֵלַח-נָא (sela'h-na) is read as סֵלַח-נָא (accent is on the last syllable of the first word instead of on the first syllable of that word)

vs 24: עֲקֹב הַיְתָה (ngékib hayetáh) is recited in *high na'úm*

vs 34: יוֹם לַשָּׁנָה (yom lashanáh) is recited in *high na'úm*

vs 36: וַיִּלְנוּ is read as וַיִּלְנוּ (vayaleenu)

Chapter 15:

vs 24: לַחֲטָאת is read as לַחֲטָאת (le'hatat)

vs 28: בְּחִטָּה (bechit'ah) is read with "ה" (hé) unpronounced

vs 31: עֹנֶה (ngavonáh) is read with "ה" (hé) unpronounced

קֹרַח (Kórach), 5th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 16:

vs 3: וַיַּעֲקֹבֵנוּ (vayeeqáhalú) is recited in *high na'úm*

vs 11: תִּלְנוּ is read as תִּלְנוּ (talénu)

vs 30: וְאִם-בְּרִיָּאָה (ve'eém-beree'áh) is recited in *high na'úm*

Chapter 17:

vs 3: וַעֲשׂוּ אֹתָם (vengasú otám) is recited as וַעֲשׂוּ אֹתָם in *high na'úm* ****

Chapter 18:

vs 9: לַחֹל-מֵעַן הָאֵתָם (lachól-meen'hataám) is recited in *high na'úm* (see Rules for Pronunciation, item c)

vs 15: לַחֹל-בָּשָׂר (láchol-basar) is recited in *high na'úm* (see Rules for Pronunciation, item c)

חֻקַּת (Chukat), 6th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 19:

vs 4: וְהִזָּהּ is recited as וְהִזָּה (veheezah)*

vs 12: הִנָּא יִתְחַטֵּא-בוֹ (hu-yeet'hatta'-bo) is recited in *high na'um*

Chapter 21:

verses 17-20: are recited in *high na'um* without a stop.

vs 20: וּמַבְמוֹת (umeebamot) is recited as וּמַבְמוֹת in *high na'um* ***

After vs 20 a stop; regular na'um is resumed.

vs 32: וַיִּירֶשׁ is read as וַיִּירֶשׁ (vayorish)

vs 34: כִּי בְיַדְךָ (kee beyadecha) is recited in *high na'um*.

In Amsterdam pronunciation is kee beeyadecha (see Rules for Pronunciation in Amsterdam only, item c)

בַּלָּק (Balak), 7th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 23:

vs 13: לֶחָ-נָא אֲתִי is recited as לֶחָ-נָא אֲתִי (lecha-na eeteé) in *high na'um* ****

פִּינְחָס (Peenechas), 8th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 26:

vs 9: קְרִיאָנִי is read as קְרִיאָנִי (keree'e)

: אֲשֶׁר הֵצִיּוּ is recited as אֲשֶׁר הֵצִיּוּ (asher heetzu)**

Chapter 28:

vs 26: בְּהַקְרִיבְכֶם is recited as בְּהַקְרִיבְכֶם (behakreebechim)**

מַטּוֹת (Mattot), 9th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 32:

vs 7: תִּנְיֵאוֹן is read as תִּנְיֵאוֹן tenee'un)

vs 29: אֶת--הַיַּרְדֵּן (it-hayardin) is recited in *high na'um*

מַסְעֵי (Masge), 10th weekly portion of the book of Numbers

Chapter 34:

vs 4: וְהָיָה is read as וְהָיָה (vehayu)

vs 12: הַגְּבוּל is read as הַגְּבוּל (haguebul)

vs 14: כִּי לַקְחוּ (kee lake'hu) is recited in *high na'um*

vs 15: לקחו נחלתם is recited as לקחון נחלתם (lake'hú na'halatám), the אזל (א) (azlá) and זקוף קטון (ז) (zakíf katon) are replaced by a שופר הולך (ש) (shofár hollich) and a רביע (ר) (rebée'áng)

Chapter 35:

vs 21: אנ באיבה (o be'ébah) is recited in *high na'um*

Chapter 36:

vs 6: זך הדבר (zé haddabár) is recited in *high na'um*

vs 13 is recited in *high na'um* with אלה המצות (éle hameetsvót) recited in *high na'um*.

DEUTERONOMY

דברים (Debareém), 1st weekly portion and Hebrew name of the 5th book, Deuteronomy, of the pentateuch

Chapter 2:

vs 33: ואת-בניו is read as ואת-בניו (ve'it-banáv)

Chapter 3:

vs 2: כפי בגידך (kee beyádechá) is recited in *high na'um*.

In Amsterdam, pronunciation is kee béeyádechá (see Rules for Pronunciation for Amsterdam only, item c)

vs 11: הלה is read as הלא (hallo)

ואתחנן (Va'it'hanán), 2nd weekly portion of the book of Deuteronomy

Chapter 4:

vs 9: פן-תשכח את-הדברים (pin-teeshká'h it-haddebareém) is recited as פן-תשכח את-הדברים in *high na'um* ****

verses 25 - 40 are recited in low voice

After vs 40 no interruption of שלישי (sheleeshee) but rather after vs 49
